Mr Giordimaina has been Executive Chairman of Enemalta since 18<sup>th</sup> November 2011.

Since May 2008 he is also Board Chairman of the Water Services Corporation, which is responsible for the supply and distribution of water as well as for the disposal of waste water.

Mr Giordimaina was instrumental is setting up Lufthansa Technik Malta in 2002 and was its first CEO until September 2011. Lufthansa Technik Malta is a joint venture between Lufthansa Technik AG (92%) and Air Malta (8%). Based at Malta International Airport, the company carries out maintenance, repair and overhaul services for both narrow-body and wide-body aircraft types such as the Airbus A320, A330 and A340 and Boeing aircraft.

Mr Giordimaina is now a Board member of Lufthansa Technik Malta.

Prior to 2002, he worked with Air Malta, the national airline, for 27 years. He worked in various positions in the Engineering Department of the company, the last 10 years of which he was the first Maltese Chief Engineer responsible for the whole Engineering and Maintenance Department of the airline, including with responsibilities for strategic planning as well as sale and leasing of aircraft.

Mr Giordimaina is involved in a number of philantrophic organisations in Malta.
