Nick is currently Professor of Psychology at Cardiff University, where he directs the Understanding Risk Research Group (www.understanding-risk.org). He is also Principal Investigator on the UKERC project 'Transforming the UK energy system – Public values, attitudes and acceptability'. His research looks at risk perception, risk communication, and public engagement with environmental and technological risks. Currently vice-Chair of the DEFRA/DECC social sciences expert panel, and from 2010-2013 a member of the Chief Scientist's independent Science Advisory Group at DECC. Co-editor with Roger Kasperson and Paul Slovic of *The Social Amplification of Risk*, Cambridge University Press, 2003 and with the late Barry Turner of the 2nd edition of *Man Made Disasters*, Butterworth Heinemann, 1997. He is a Fellow of the Society for Risk Analysis and an Honorary Fellow of the British Science Association.
